# FROM PRINCIPAL ORTEGA'S DESK \*\*\*\*\*MARCH--2ND TRIMESTER REPORTS 3-8-19\*\*\*\*\*



Thank you, parents, for taking these surveys they really do help us shape our programing. The Safety Survey was taken in the fall and here are some findings that I thought would be of interest to you:

#### **Student Responses 3rd-6th:**

How safe do you feel at school?

How often do you see bullying?

How well do you know emergency procedures at school?

89% very safe / safe
72% very little / never
88% avg. very well / well

The least favorable response was : Students get teased at school because of learning difficulties

5% responded often, 20% responded sometimes.

These are only partial results but I wanted all to know that the majority of students feel safe at school and appear to know what to do in case of emergency. There are areas of concern that we need your help with in regards to treating others with respect and empathy. These are areas that we address in school and we appreciate any support you provide at home to reinforce respectful and empathetic behavior to their peers and other adults.



On that note, we are providing extra programing from the SJPD Crime Prevention division to come in and discuss Social Media and Cyberbullying to our 5th and 6th graders. We will also be hosting a Parent Night on Tuesday 3-19-19 @ 6:00pm-7:30pm to address the same concerns and perhaps touch on some broader topics. Please join us.

Also, The City of San Jose Traffic Division will be presenting a 'Street Smart' assembly to all our students at the end of this month. This program teaches many aspects of being 'Street Smart' and being aware of traffic dangers. PLEASE PARENTS take advantage of our crossing guards and demonstrate to your child to cross ONLY at crosswalks and to make sure to look both ways always.
