In the meantime, this all couldn't happen without the contributions and efforts of the JFS community. For additional information on ways you can help, please take a moment to read through this newsletter.




Support JFS STEAM Lab and other PTA Programs

Last year, JFS achieved a BIG milestone! We launched an on-site STEAM program and STEAM lab which will benefit all grade levels for years to come. STEAM is an important program to further enhance our school's curriculum in **Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math**. With a STEAM program and a lab, teachers now can easily integrate STEAM into their curriculum. It was a dream come true. Without the strong support of so many parents, school staff, and a financial grant from the district, this program would not have been possible.

Why is STEM education so important? It is important because it pervades every part of our lives. STEAM education creates critical thinkers, increases science literacy, and enables the next generation of innovators. Additionally STEM careers are the fastest growing as compare to other non-STEM careers. And STEM degree holders overall have a higher income even in non-STEM occupations. By exposing students to STEM and giving them more opportunities in school to explore STEM-related concepts, we hope to spark an interest in pursuing a STEM career in our students.

Building upon our success from last year, this year our goal is to raise **\$100,000**. The majority of your pledge would go towards tools and supplies for the lab and the *instructional coaching* (an instructor) needed for a successful STEAM program. The remaining funds raised will go towards supporting our teachers with a supply fund to help stock their classrooms, updated technology (i.e., replacement Chromebooks), and enrichment programs such as Math Olympiad, Drama, etc. Without parent support and donations, the school is at the risk of losing all these wonderful programs.

To date, we are only 10% of the way there. Please consider making a donation.
